I am to inform you that the next meeting of Performance Review Committee (PRC) will be held on 23rd & 24th January, 2014 at ICAR, NASC Complex, Pusa, New Delhi-110012. During the meeting, the performance of the programmes, viz., MGNREGA, NRLM, IAY, NSAP, Socio Economic & Caste Census, Training and Vigilance & Monitoring Committee will be reviewed along with Skill Development and Information Technology (IT) in implementation of rural development programmes. The focus of the review will be on the following issues.

- o Action Taken Report on the last PRC meeting held on 24th & 25th September 2013;
- o Financial & physical performance of the States in each of the rural development programmes during 2013-14 and action required for 2014-15;
- o Specific discussion on capacity building of individual States for better implementation of the RD programmes;
- o Review of data entry in MGNREGA Soft, AWAAS Soft and NSAP-MIS. Seeding of Aadhaar numbers in the programme in 2013-14, the database and implementation of Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) process.

I have directed the Joint Secretaries in charge of the programmes to coordinate with States to finalize the important pending issues likely to be discussed in the meeting. **Since the programmes are reviewed based on the data / reports received through the web-based monitoring / MIS of various programme, you may kindly ensure that the data / reports etc. are up to date.**
