विषय:- मनरेगा अंतर्गत वैयक्तिक पारिवारिक शौचालय के निर्माण के संबंध में अतिरिक्त दिशानिर्देश ।

सन्दर्भ :- 1. मनरेगा अधिनियम के अनुसूची-1 में अद्यतन संशोधन ।  
2. उक्त क्रम में भारत सरकार का पत्रांक J-11017/41/2013-MGNREGA (UN) दिनांक 06.01.2014 ।

महाशय,

महात्मा गाँधी राष्ट्रीय ग्रामीण रोजगार गारंटी अधिनियम के अनुसूची-1 संख्या-2 में अद्यतन संशोधन करते हुए अनुसूची-1 की कंडिका 4 (1) IV (i) अंतर्गत निम्नलिखित प्रावधान किए गए हैं :-

*"Rural sanitation related works, such as, individual household latrines, school toilet units, Anganwadi toilets either independently or in convergence with schemes of other Government Departments to achieve 'open defecation free' status, and solid and liquid waste management as per prescribed norms."*

उक्त के आलोक में भारत सरकार द्वारा दिशानिर्देश निर्गत किया गया है । सुलभ प्रसंग हेतु प्रति संलग्न । इस क्रम में वैयक्तिक पारिवारिक शौचालयों के निर्माण के संबंध में निम्नवत अतिरिक्त दिशानिर्देश दिये जाते हैं :-

1. निर्मल भारत अभियान तथा मनरेगा की निधि के अभिसरण से संबंधित व्यवस्था राज्य सरकार के द्वारा निर्गत संकल्प (संसूचन पत्रांक 689 दिनांक 07.08.2013) तथा उक्त क्रम में निर्गत संयुक्त परिपत्र (पत्रांक 731 दिनांक 06.09.2013) के अनुसार पूर्ववत रहेगी । मनरेगा मद में देय अधिकतम राशि की सीमा 4500/- रुपये (चार हजार पाँच सौ रुपये) से बढ़ाकर 5400/- रुपये (पाँच हजार चार


सौ रुपये) की जाती है। इंदिरा आवास योजना अंतर्गत शौचालय का निर्माण अभिसरण के तहत ही पूर्ववत् किया जाएगा।

2. वैयक्तिक पारिवारिक शौचालय का निर्माण कार्य स्वतंत्र रूप से मनरेगा की निधि से अधिकतम 10000/- रुपये की सीमा तक किया जा सकेगा। इस तरीके से वैयक्तिक पारिवारिक शौचालय का निर्माण कराने हेतु यह आवश्यक होगा कि श्रमसाध्य योजनाओं के कार्यान्वयन से सृजित मानव दिवस के विरुद्ध श्रम-सामग्री के अनुपात के अधीन प्राथमिकता के आधार पर सर्वप्रथम शौचालय निर्माण का कार्य कराया जाएगा।

इस संबंध में पूर्व में निर्गत दिशानिर्देशों को इस हद तक संशोधित समझा जाय।

4. (1) The focus of the Scheme shall be on the following works as categorised below:

I. Category A: PUBLIC WORKS RELATING TO NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT -

- (i) **Water conservation** and water harvesting structures to augment and improve groundwater like underground dykes, earthen dams, stop dams, check dams with special focus on recharging ground water including drinking water sources;
- (ii) **Watershed management** works such as contour trenches, terracing, contour bunds, boulder checks, gabion structures and spring shed development resulting in a comprehensive treatment of a watershed;
- (iii) Micro and minor irrigation works and creation, renovation and maintenance of **irrigation** canals and drains;
- (iv) Renovation of **traditional water bodies** including desilting of irrigation tanks and other water bodies;
- (v) **Afforestation**, tree plantation and horticulture in common and forest lands, road margins, canal bunds, tank foreshores and coastal belts duly providing right to usufruct to the households covered in Paragraph 5; and
- (vi) Land development works in common land.

II. Category B: INDIVIDUAL ASSETS FOR VULNERABLE SECTIONS (ONLY FOR HOUSEHOLDS IN PARAGRAPH 5)

- (i) **Improving productivity of lands** of households specified in Paragraph 5 through land development and by providing suitable infrastructure for irrigation including dug wells, farm ponds and other water harvesting structures;
- (ii) **Improving livelihoods through** horticulture, sericulture, plantation, and farm forestry;
- (iii) **Development of fallow or waste lands** of households defined in Paragraph 5 to bring it under cultivation;
- (iv) Unskilled wage component in **construction of houses** sanctioned under the Indira Awaas Yojana or such other State or Central Government Scheme;
- (v) Creating infrastructure for **promotion of livestock** such as, poultry shelter, goat shelter, piggery shelter, cattle shelter and fodder troughs for cattle; and
- (vi) Creating infrastructure for **promotion of fisheries** such as, fish drying yards, storage facilities, and promotion of fisheries in seasonal water bodies on public land;

III. Category C: COMMON INFRASTRUCTURE FOR NRLM COMPLIANT SELF HELP GROUPS

- (i) Works for promoting **agricultural productivity** by creating durable infrastructure required for bio-fertilizers and post-harvest facilities including pucca storage facilities for agricultural produce; and
- (ii) Common work-sheds for livelihood activities of self-help groups.

IV. Category D: RURAL INFRASTRUCTURE:

- (i) **Rural sanitation** related works, such as, individual household latrines, school toilet units, Anganwadi toilets either independently or in convergence with schemes of other Government Departments to achieve 'open defecation free' status, and solid and liquid waste management as per prescribed norms
- (ii) Providing all-weather rural **road connectivity** to unconnected villages and to connect identified rural production centres to the existing pucca road network;

**Subject: Rural sanitation works under MGNREGS.**

Sir/Madam,

As per the Para 4 (1) IV (i) of the Schedule - I of the MGNREG Act, amended vide Notification Dated 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2013, taking up rural sanitation related works, such as, individual household latrines, school toilets, Anganwadi toilets can be taken up **either independently or in convergence** with schemes of other Government Departments to achieve 'open defecation free' status.

2. The earlier guidelines for works relating to access to sanitation under MGNREGA were issued vide circular No. J-11017/41/ 2011-MGNREGA (Pt.) dated 11.09.2012, 13.06.2013 and 19.08.2013. These guidelines prescribe the mode of convergence between the MGNREGS and Nirmal Bharat Abhiyaan (NBA) Schemes.


3. In view of the modification in the Schedule I of the Act and the increase in the wage rates since 2011, the following amendment has been made to the existing guidelines:

- a) Individual Household latrine (IHHL) works can be taken up either under convergence with NBA or independently under MGNREGS, as per the choice of the beneficiary.
- b) Where IHHLs are taken up in convergence with NBA, the guidelines issued vide Ministry of Rural Development circular No. J-11017/41/ 2011- MGNREGA (Pt.) dated 11. 09.2012, 13.06.2013, and 19.08.2013 will remain applicable including the beneficiary contribution. However, the MGNREGS component stands increased from the present Rs. 4,500 to Rs. 5,400 keeping in view the revision of wages.
- c) Where IHHLs are taken up independently under MGNREGS, the following shall be kept in view:
  - i. The payment shall be based on the actual value of work done, subject to the overall outflow from MGNREGS funds limited to Rs.10,000 per IHHL including the wage and material cost. Any expenditure over and above this amount shall be the beneficiary contribution.
  - ii. The designs and specifications shall continue to be as laid down by the Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation, GOI.
  - iii. The data of such IHHLs shall be shared with the agencies implementing the NBA to ensure that no further incentive is paid from the NBA funds. There shall be no duplication between the toilets taken up under NBA in convergence with MGNREGS and independently under MGNREGS. The Gram Panchayat authorities will be responsible for ensuring this.
  - iv. For all works taken up by the Gram Panchayats, including the rural sanitation works taken up based on the above guidelines, the cost of the

material component including the wages of the skilled and semi-skilled workers shall not exceed forty per cent at the Gram Panchayat level.

4. Guidelines for other rural sanitation works would be issued separately.
5. All the Spl. CS/Principal Secretaries/Secretaries of Rural Development are requested to communicate these guidelines to all their field functionaries for ensuring a better performance in rural sanitation programme.
