महाशय,



अतः आपसे अनुरोध है कि जिलों के द्वारा मासिक प्रगति प्रतिवेदन भेजने एवं आवास साफ्ट पर प्रगति के अपलोड करने के अतिरिक्त प्रत्येक माह की 5 वीं तारीख तक विहित प्रपत्र में प्रतिवेदन विभाग को निश्चित रूप से भेजें ।



Dear Shri Raju,

As you are aware, Indira Awaas Yojana is a flagship scheme of the Ministry of Rural Development under which financial assistance is provided to the rural BPL households for construction of a house. The goal of the scheme can be effectively achieved if the funds released to the DRDAs are further transferred to the beneficiaries without unnecessary delay and the unspent balance is brought to the minimum.

2. It is however, observed from the MPRs that the DRDAs in the States/UTs are not transferring the funds to the beneficiaries immediately, as a result the unspent balance with the DRDAs and Block offices, is increasing. As on 30.9.2014, the total unspent balance with the States under IAY was Rs. 9149 crore. I would also like to add that in view of the Government's goal to provide pucca houses to all by the year 2022, the monitoring of IAY is being done at the highest level where the position of huge unspent balance with the States, has been viewed very seriously.

3. With a view to monitor the fund flow from the DRDA upto the beneficiary level, a proforma has been devised in two parts (Table-1 and 2) to capture release of funds up to beneficiary level on a monthly basis along with the cumulative figures for the year, a copy of which is enclosed. I would request you to furnish the requisite information on the format indicating both the monthly and cumulative release figures, by 10th of every month. The information relating to November, 2014 must reach this Ministry by 10th of December, 2014 and so on. This would be in addition to the on-line MPR or the data presently being uploaded on the MIS-AwaasSoft. Please issue necessary instructions to your district officials for this reporting.
