महाशय,

उपर्युक्त विषयक प्रसांगिक पत्र द्वारा भारत सरकार से मनरेगा योजनाओं के क्रियान्वयन के प्रसंग में मार्गदर्शन प्राप्त हुआ है जो निम्नलिखित है :-

1. भारत सरकार के पत्र दिनांक 31.10.2016 द्वारा Focus area अंतर्गत IHHL, AWC, Vermi Compost/ NADEP फार्म पोंड्स (Farm Ponds), की प्रगति की समीक्षा करते हुए दिनांक 31.03.2017 तक कार्य पूर्ण करने हेतु निर्देश दिया गया है । इस संबंध में विभागीय बैठकों एवं विडियो कान्फ्रेंस में भी बार-बार श्रम बजट में निर्धारित लक्ष्य की प्राप्ति हेतु निर्देश दिए गये हैं ।
2. भारत सरकार के पत्र दिनांक 18 नवम्बर, 2016 द्वारा स्पष्ट किया गया है कि मनरेगा अधिनियम, 2005 के प्रावधान के अंतर्गत निजी भूमि पर नये फार्म पोंड्स (Farm Ponds) का ही निर्माण किया जाना है, इसकी पुनर्खुदाई अथवा जीर्णोद्धार (re-excavation / renovation) अनुमान्य नहीं है ।

अतएव भारत सरकार के दोनों पत्रों की प्रति संलग्न करते हुए अनुरोध है कि उक्त पत्रों के आलोक में कृपया कार्रवाई सुनिश्चित किया जाय तथा संबंधित को निदेशित किया जाय ।

Sub: Regarding re-excavation/renovation of farm pond on private land.

A.

Madam/Sir,

It has been found that few states are undertaking re-excavation/renovation of farm ponds on private land which is not a permissible activity under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA.

Schedule I para 4.II (i) of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act 2005, provides for 'Improving productivity of lands of households specified in Paragraph 5 through land development and by providing suitable infrastructure for irrigation including dug wells, farm ponds and other water harvesting structures'.

It is clear that the provision relates to creation of new farm ponds on private land. It is reiterated that re-excavation /renovation of farm pond is not listed as a permissible activity on private land and, hence, cannot not be undertaken.

You are, therefore requested to ensure that only those work / activities that are permitted under the Act are be undertaken. Works, other than what are permitted, are strictly prohibited.

This may kindly be brought to the knowledge of all concerned.


