

Dear Anjani,

As you are aware, to support the States and Districts in the implementation of the Swachh Bharat Mission, the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation with support from the Tata Trusts, is deploying 600 Young Professionals – Zila Swachh Bharat Preraks (ZSBP) – in districts across the country for one year. These Preraks are envisioned to be full-time dedicated resources to help District Collectors/ District Magistrates to manage and scale-up the implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission Gramin in your state.

These Preraks are identified through a stringent selection process and allocated to the states and districts they prefer. There is also a flexibility to post them to the districts preferred by the State as per coverage and ODF status of various districts. These Preraks undergo a three-day orientation programme in different batches in New Delhi by trainers from Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation before they are deployed to the States.

State wise letters are sent to Principal Secretary or Secretary in-charge of SBM with a request to advise DM/DC to provide accommodation and mobility facilities for initial few weeks at the district level till they find a permanent accommodation in the district. The same letter is also copied to the concerned DMs. Preraks are provided with the contact details of their DMs for reporting after the training is completed in New Delhi. So far, 280 Preraks from seven batches have been deployed across the country.

As we are experiencing varying degrees of support from districts on this issue, you are requested to communicate with the DMs to provide minimum facilities to

Dear Shri Singh,

As you are aware, Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) aims for freedom from Open Defecation in the rural areas of the country by October 2nd, 2019. In order to create an ODF India, it is important to have toilet facilities in public areas across the country where congregations of a large number of people take place.

2. Playgrounds/Playfields in Gram Panchayats of rural India are such public places where toilets and drinking water facilities need to be provided. As you aware, SBM(G) Guidelines provide for construction of Community Toilets/Public Toilets (CTs/PTs) in GPs. Further, States/ UTs can also use alternate funding sources like CSR, 14th Finance Commission funds, etc. to augment the funding for CTs/PTs.

3. We request you to kindly issue appropriate directions to the relevant implementing agencies regarding construction of community and public toilets in the playgrounds of all the Panchayats in your State/ UT.

4. I am sure you will agree that sports have a significant influence on human resource development, for which we must provide a clean environment and proper infrastructure at the play fields to our children. Let work towards creating a Swachh Bharat for the generations to come.

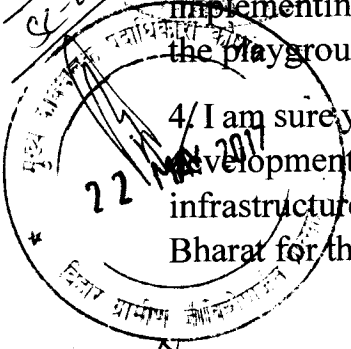
