Subject: - Regarding Problems in Payment of Data Entry Operator (DEO's) engaged in Socio-Economic Caste Census (SECC)-2011

Dear Sir,

With reference to subject mentioned above this is to state that in spite of our several request, CPSU assigned for Bihar (ECIL) has failed miserably in handling the issue of under/non payment to DEO's working in SECC-2011.

In the VC conducted on 29.04.2013, representative of ECIL, Hyderabad has assured that issue regarding under/non payment of DEO's will be sorted out within a week, but in spite of his assurance situation is as it is, even became worse in few districts like Buxar & Jehanabad. Due to under/non payment of DEO's, SECC work has stopped since January 2013 in Buxar. Jehanabad is also facing same types of problem since February 2013.

We have arranged VC on 10.05.2013 with 19 districts of Bihar and more or less all districts have conveyed same problem regarding DEO's payment. Due to under/non payment problem of DEO's our SECC work is lagging behind and that will be resulted in heavy increase in budgetary provision.

Therefore, it is requested to you to direct ECIL to resolve the issue at the earliest otherwise state will not be able to complete the enumeration phase, even by the end of May 2013.
