Dear Sir/Madam,

Please refer to the enclosed letter dated 6th June, 2018 from our Secretary requesting to update the Village Development Plan (VDP) and Panchayat Darpan reports on the Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) portal (<http://saanjhi.gov.in>), and to provide a two-page note on each SAGY Gram Panchayat on current status capturing the baseline, the interventions made, the physical progress and outcomes achieved by 13th June, 2018. It was followed by my reminder dated 8-6-2018 to your State to update the progress in SAGY MIS.

2. Although, we have received updates and two page reports from your State, they are not covering all the aspects of SAGY. I request you to provide progress of the SAGY Gram Panchayats in your State in the enclosed format in respect of each SAGY Gram Panchayat, so that they can be shared with the respective Hon'ble Members of Parliament. A copy of the illustrative example of the filled in format is also attached for reference.

3. I also request you to please expedite the implementation of projects proposed under VDPs of the SAGY Gram Panchayats and update the following data on SAGY MIS (<http://saanjhi.gov.in>):-

- Village Development Plan as well as its progress; and
- Panchayat Darpan baseline & quarterly progress upto quarter ending March, 2018 for all Gram Panchayats including Phase-I.

Subject: **Urgent 2 Page Updates on Progress under each of the RURBAN Clusters and SAGY Gram Panchayats**

Dear Principal Secretary,

As you are aware, in partnership with States, the Central Government has been working on Sustainable Development of 300 RURBAN Clusters in the country. Work has also been undertaken under the guidance of the Hon'ble Members of Parliament in the Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) in selected nearly 1500 Villages/Gram Panchayats. The Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana Programme has the *saanjhi.gov.in* web portal where the Charge Officer at the District level is expected to update reports on a regular basis. Unfortunately the reporting has not been up-to-date. As a consequence the current development status of the SAGY Gram Panchayats does not fully reflect on the *saanjhi.gov.in* website.

2. Likewise, under the RURBAN Cluster, States have prepared detailed Integrated Cluster Action Plans (ICAPs) with partnership of State Technical Agencies. These ICAPs clearly identified the gaps and also suggested the interventions required to attain urban like facilities and services in rural areas. The interventions under the RURBAN Mission are both through convergence and through an additional critical gap funding of Rs. 30 crore in non-tribal clusters and Rs. 15 crore in tribal clusters. Many States have made good progress through convergence and through the utilization of critical gap funding released by the Central Government along with the State share.

3. We would like to know the current status of the 300 RURBAN Clusters and nearly 1500 SAGY Villages/Gram Panchayats through a 2 page note on the current status capturing the baseline, the interventions made, the physical and financial progress, and the outcomes achieved. I would request you to provide this through a DO letter addressed to the undersigned (secyrd@nic.in) within 7 days for each of the 1800 Clusters listed above. This will enable us to take a proper stock taking of progress, achievements and what remains to be done. I would expect the responses of each State latest by June 13, 2018.

4. May kindly treat this as most urgent.

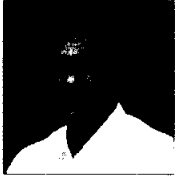

Transformation of the GP under SAGY

The Veernapalli Gram Panchayat is a very remote village located in forest area. The Gram Panchayat has 1,150 Households out of which only 30% had IHHLs before its adoption under SAGY. Now all the Households have been provided IHHLs. The Hon'ble MP, Shri B. Vinod Kumar has taken the initiative to converge all the stakeholder line departments and village water & sanitation committee members. As a result, the village has been declared as open defecation free (ODF) village. Under National Mission on Sustainable Agriculture (NMSA), 110 Soil samples were drawn and Soil Health Cards were issued to respective farmers. Under Seed Village programme, 25 farmers were selected and supplied with 30 Kg foundation seed of paddy during Kharif season. The farmers were imparted three trainings by subject experts on techniques of seed treatment, healthy nursery raising, rouging and seed storage for good seed production.
