1. The cabinet has approved the following Agenda:

- Implementation of National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM) as per the revised guidelines.
- Bearing of Interest Gap on SHG loans by State Government as Interest Subvention in the non IAP Districts.
- Implementation arrangements as per the revised Aajeevika skills guidelines.
- Implementation arrangements as per the Mahila Kisan Sashaktikaran Pariyojna (MKSP) guidelines.

2. Staffing: 2998 Community Coordinators were declared and they are expected to join in the 2nd fortnight of Jan,14. Around 200 more staff including support and managerial were also called for joining.

3. Credit Leveraging from Banks: In the current financial year a total of 11676 SHGs have been credit linked with bank with a cumulative loan amount of Rs.317 crores.

4. Skills & Placement: RSETI has established 38 training centers in which 23582 youths have been trained. In the current financial year 6440 youths have been trained and placed under skills and placement. At present 119 PIAs has applied online, out of which 69 PIA applications were duly filled.

5. MoU with WDC: A Joint Action Plan between WDC and JEEViKA has been signed with the commitment of smooth transition of SHG & federation. Further as per the Joint Action Plan district meeting has been conducted followed by block level meeting initiated.
