	78	<p>It appears that the State Government then framed the Rashtriya Gramin Rojgar Guarantee Yojana 2005. Clause 12.5 provided, for the purpose of the present controversy, that at the Panchayat Samiti level the cheques were to be signed by the Pramukh and the Block Development Officer. Submission on behalf of the petitioners therefore was that the government instructions by letter dated 11.9.2006 at Annexure 2, which provides that cheques with regard to funds under the Saarpurn Gramin Rojgar Yojana shall be signed only by the Block Development Officer, was contrary to the statutory regulations framed by the State Government. The statutory regulation could not be amended by an executive instruction in the form of letter, as is sought to be done.</p> <p>During the course of submission learned Counsel for the State has placed before this Court the regulations framed by the State Government in the year 2005 as amended in September 2006. Clause 12.5 of the amended regulations states that at the Panchayat Samiti level the cheque shall bear the solitary signature of the Block Development Officer. This Court finds no merit in the submission that the regulations of the State Government as amended in September 2006 is only a proposal and has not been given effect to.</p> <p>In view of the amended regulations framed by the State Government in exercise of powers under Section 3(ii) of the National Employment Guarantee Act, 2005,</p>
